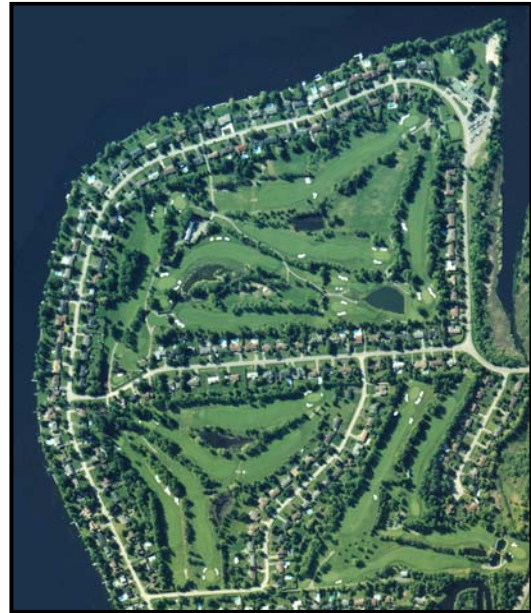

THE CLUB

Founded in October 1962, as the Rideau Carleton Golf & Yacht Club, by Penn-Can Development, **Carleton Golf & Yacht Club** became a member-owned and operated private club on January 2, 1967.

As a member-owned club, Carleton delivers on all the cherished benefits of the private-golf experience while maintaining its best-value position in the Ottawa market. Pristine conditions, personalized service, and a priceless sense of community are just a few of the reasons people play Carleton. Traditional in design, the course fills the senses with the colour and diffused light of mature mixed trees, the sparkle of white silica sand and the captivating natural ponds, home to a variety of non-golfing species. The spirit of the club revolves around a friendly, casual atmosphere with tremendous member involvement, volunteerism, respect for others, and sense of belonging. At Carleton, it's not about profit; everything is done for the members.

Tucked in a scenic setting on an islet of the Rideau River, the course is within minutes of the communities of Manotick, Barrhaven and Riverside South. From downtown Ottawa, a relaxing 30-minute drive south on highway 416 clears your head and puts you on the tee with the lush green carpet ahead of you and work far behind.



GOLF ACTIVITIES

One of the most treasured benefits for the members of Carleton is all the organized leagues, playing events, tournaments, social events, and the varying levels of competitive events. The annual playing calendar is packed, with a wide selection of activities from which to choose. Carleton has a broad mix of players with a good balance between male and female golfers, older and younger, singles and couples, families and juniors; So you can play with the guys, your spouse, your friends, the gals, the kids, or any combination there of. In terms of regular league play, the club has two men's leagues, played on Wednesday; two women's leagues, played on Tuesday and Saturday; a fun mixed league on Thursday evenings; and junior events on Monday mornings. In addition to the league events, there are some nine and dine evenings for members and guests scattered throughout the summer; special holiday-Monday fun golf/dinner events; annual member-guest events; and various Saturday/Sunday club competitions, including the ultimate – the Club Championship. At the competitive level, Carleton is home course to some of Ottawa's top golfers and many of Carleton's men, women and juniors successfully compete in the regional golf association competitions including Intersectionals, Interclub, Field Days, City & District Championships, and the Ottawa Citizen Amateur Golf Championship.

THE COURSE

Host to the 1998 and 2002 CPGA Senior's Championships, Carleton offers excellent shot-value and will hone every element of your game. While pleasantly walkable, the track is by no means lacking in complexity or challenge. With water on 10 holes, devilishly well-placed bunkers, and tempting twists and turns, you will soon become familiar with the term "risk and reward".

Carleton is fortunate to have one of the region's best greenskeepers, **Joel Trickey**, working his magic on the course over that past 11 years. Joel sets very high standards for his team and their work and this shows up in spades. No matter what the weatherman throws at him, Joel always stays calm and seems to be able to make the best of it.

The small but important things never get missed – full drinking water dispensers, freshly raked bunkers, precisely trimmed aprons around the greens, ball washers at each tee, with soapy water and clean towels! Divot repair sand/seed mix bins full and close by.

PRACTICE FACILITIES

Whether priming for the final round of the club championship or practicing what you learned in yesterday's lesson, our practice areas will help you fine tune each element of your game. Facilities include driving range, practice putting green, and short game area.

CLUBHOUSE

The original clubhouse was in place for the opening of the 1964 golf season. That building was mostly destroyed by fire in the fall of 1989 and replaced in September 1990 with a modern facility housing several dining areas, meeting rooms, locker rooms, pro shop, and club and cart storage areas.

The balcony is always a fun place to finish your round with a refreshment, regale your friends with highlights from your round, and hang back to watch the comings and goings. If you've had enough heat on the course, perhaps with a little too much time baking in one of those bright silica sand bunkers, then the air conditioned bar/lounge is maybe a better place to chill out, and you'll still have a panoramic view of the 1st and 18th holes.

Our Head Chef **Peter Veit** and his team offer up a range of delectable cuisine from the tried and true golf course favourites to the creative and International fare. During the summer, it's always nice to know you have a place to take family and friends; where you are surrounded by familiar faces and can count on quality food and personal service. And wait until you experience one of the special club events – such as Member-Guest day or the Club Championship/Hole-in-one Party. You will be amazed with the caliber of service and presentation to the 250+ participants. As Peter can attest, there is not a more discerning dining room customer than a private club member, and Peter's been rising to the challenge for over 10 years.

Carleton has found that talent in **Greg Richardson, CCM**, who has filled those big shoes for 8 years and counting. Greg's dedication and service to the club are reflected in the improvements the club has seen during his tenure. He has most recently attained his **Certified Club Manager (CCM) designation**, one of only 25 in Canada and the only one in Eastern Ontario! Greg is also active on the National Board of the Canadian Society of Club Managers.

GENERAL INFORMATION

ATTIRE

Golfers must wear proper golf attire at all times in the clubhouse and on the golf course and practice areas. Ladies shirts must be round neck, mock or collar with sleeves, OR mock or collar with no sleeves. Men's shirts must have collars and sleeves or be mock neck and must be tucked in. Men's socks, when worn with shorts, must be either knee socks or sockets (no banded sports or dress socks).

PROHIBITED: Shorts, skirts or skorts higher than mid-thigh, jogging apparel, sweat suits, tank or halter tops, tee shirts, jeans and cut-offs.

The Starter, Player Assistant and/or Senior Staff member have the authority to restrict the play of those not appropriately dressed.

PACE OF PLAY

The accepted standard for Pace of Play at Carleton is 4 hours 15 minutes.

GUESTS

Guests may be invited to the Clubhouse but must be accompanied by a member at all times. Members introducing guests are responsible for their attire, indebtedness and behaviour and shall familiarize them with club rules. Guest privileges include the use of golf facilities, locker rooms, showers, Bar, Lounge and Dining facilities.

PLAYING RESTRICTIONS

- **Weekday Members** – may play anytime Monday to Friday and on public holidays. They may play after 3pm on Saturdays and Sundays.
- **Junior Members** – may play at the following times:
 - Monday to Thursday – Anytime with Priority given to League Play
 - Friday – After 12 noon
 - Saturday – After 1:30pm (Junior Program)
 - Sunday – Anytime with member parent OR if invited by a Full Golfer; otherwise after 1pm
 - Holidays – PM Draw Only

NOTE: Junior Members can reserve a starting time **three(3) days** in advance

- **Social or Out-of-Town Members** – may play eight (8) times per year by paying green fees and have the privilege of booking tee times within the guest scheduled guidelines.
- **Guests** – A member may introduce guests as per the following schedule:
 - Weekdays – Maximum of three (3) guests
 - Wednesdays – One (1) guest only after 12 noon.
 - Saturday – Maximum of three (3) guests, after 12pm only.
 - Sunday – Maximum of three (3) guests, after 11am only.
 - Holidays – No guests in the morning draw. Maximum of two (2) guests, afternoon only.

NOTE: No guest may play more that FIVE (5) games of golf in a single season at Carleton Golf & Yacht Club.
